

(Ps 103.2, 3) Praise the Lord O my soul and forget not all of His benefits, who forgives all my sins and heals all my diseases. (Is 53.5) And by His wounds I am healed. (Gal 3.13) Christ redeemed me from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for me, for it is written: "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree." (James 5.15) And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise Him up. (Mark 16. 17, 18) These signs will follow me because I believe: ... (Eph 2.10) I am God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works which God prepared in advance for me to do.
